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## Adolescent Drug Abuse Diagnosis (ADAD)

### Creating Assessment

1. **Entry Steps:** Login, Select Facility, Client List, Search for and Select Client.
2. Click **Activity List** within your search results.
3. Click **Assessments** on left-hand menu tree.
4. Click **ADAD**.
5. When the Adolescent Drug Abuse Diagnosis (ADAD) table screen opens, click **Add ADAD Record**.
